THE TIME BARRIER

3 Lies We Believe:

- Lie #1-- Things will SETTLE DOWN someday.
- Lie #2-- A little more will be ENOUGH.
- Lie #3 – EVERYBODY lives like this.

Luke 10: 38-42

- Martha gets reprimanded for SERVING Jesus.
- Sometimes you may need to forego good things to devote time and energy to BETTER things.
- Make the main thing the BUCKET Thing.
- Eliminate Time- STEALERS.
- Be INTERRUPTIBLE.

Main Point: Do you live at a pace that allows you to be
AVAILABLE to those around you?

THE FEAR BARRIER

Joshua 2: 9-11

- Non-Stop News and wrestling with your fears....
- Neighboring stuff is MESSY.
- Fear will distort your PERSPECTIVE.
- Learn to question your questions: “Is this an assumption OR is this true?”
- Move to the FRONT YARD !

⁹ and said to the men, “I know that the LORD has given you the land, and that the fear of you has fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land melt away before you.

¹⁰ For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red Sea before you when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to the two kings of the Amorites who were beyond the Jordan, to Sihon and Og, whom you devoted to destruction.

¹¹ And as soon as we heard it, our hearts melted, and there was no spirit left in any man because of you, for the LORD your God, he is God in the heavens above and on the earth beneath.
