Mountain Moving Prayer (2)

Mathew 8: 5-13; 1 Corinthians 15: 20- 26; John 16: 24

Pray with Confidence.

- Grow us up!
- We are at war.
- Pray as partners with God.
- We are allies in the invasion of God's Kingdom.

Pray with Authority- Mathew 8:5-10

- **TURN** your gaze in the direction of God.
Mark 6:41- 44 Jesus "looked up."
Refresh your awareness of God's power, reign & wisdom.
- "In Jesus' name"? God wants you to use the authority of ruler of the **GALAXIES**
- Jesus was **ASTONISHED** at the centurion's grasp of authority.
Lost through Adam's disobedience
Regained and won back by Christ's death and resurrection!
But the invasion and victory isn't final until Jesus 2nd coming.
1 Corinthians 15: 25--- "until...."

Until we learn that life is war, we won't totally understand what prayer is for!

MOUNTAIN-MOVING PRAYER CARD

Bible Reading: Mathew 8: 5-13; 1 Corinthians 15: 20-26; John 16: 24

5 When he had entered Capernaum, a centurion came forward to him, appealing to him, 6 "Lord, my servant is lying paralyzed at home, suffering terribly."

7 And he said to him, "I will come and heal him." 8 But the centurion replied, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you come under my roof, but only say the word, and my servant will be healed.

9 For I too am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. And I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes, and to another, 'Come,' and he comes, and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

10 When Jesus heard this, he marveled and said to those who followed him, "Truly, I tell you, with no one in Israel have I found such faith.

11 I tell you, many will come from east and west and recline at table with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven,

12 while the sons of the kingdom will be thrown into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

13 And to the centurion Jesus said, "Go; let it be done for you as you have believed." And the servant was healed at that very moment.

1 Corinthians 15: 20-26

²⁰ But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹ For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead.

²² For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. ²³ But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ.

²⁴ Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power.

²⁵ For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. ²⁶ The last enemy to be destroyed is death.
